POSTSCRIPT

ROP *CENTERS* are unique in that:

- 1. They host programs which require large spaces rarely available on a traditional campus.**



How many high schools have the space for diesel mechanics, welding, HVAC, veterinary assisting, to name a few ?



3. They attract teachers who can provide industry level certifications and devote their full attention to one program.

2. They offer “economy of scale” in that dollars spent to operate and maintain a center do not need to be duplicated at other sites, yet students from multiple schools and districts benefit from program access. SVCTE serves 44 schools.

Most ROP’s operate their classes on the campuses of their participating districts, a less efficient model which limits the number of students who may participate.

Sadly, existing funding formulas instituted in 2013 with the adoption of the LCFF seriously disadvantage JPA’s which operate as CENTERS.

4. CTE CENTERS represent the best of what we value about public education:



They are monuments to educational equity.

SVCTE educates students from all socio-economic backgrounds, ethnicities and learning styles.

We provide access to multiple career pathways including college , as our courses meet A-G university requirements.

5. They foster individual and collective well-being.

- **Provide essential workers in the health services.**
- **Provide the community with first responders, and students ready to enter the fire service and law enforcement.**
